

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT:

This Instrument of Government replaces the Instrument of Government of Leatherhead Trinity School and Children's Centre made by Surrey County Council that came into effect on 1st October 2014.

- 1. The name of the school is Leatherhead Trinity School and Nursery.
- 2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of Leatherhead Trinity School and Nursery".
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. Three parent governors;
 - b. One Local Authority governor;
 - c. One staff governor;
 - d. One Headteacher;
 - e. Three foundation governors;
 - f. Three co-opted governors.
- 5. Total number of governors 12.
- 6. The three foundation governors are to be appointed as follows:
 - a. One foundation governor to be appointed by the Parochial Church Council of the Parish of Leatherhead in the Diocese of Guildford, in the county of Surrey:
 - b. One foundation governor to be appointed by the Circuit Meeting of the Dorking and Horsham Methodist Circuit;
 - c. One foundation governor is to be appointed by the Church Meeting of Christ Church United Reformed Church.
- 7. The school has a trust.
- 8. Ethos Statement
 - Raise aspirations and academic outcomes through Quality First Teaching with a rich specialist curriculum for the diverse community in which Leatherhead Trinity School and Nursery is located - music, languages, sports, creative arts, science, technology, engineering and outdoor learning.
 - Celebrate all our children's achievements through a growth mindset culture with positive risk-taking showcasing the talents of our children with new experiences throughout our community.
 - Build our children's strength and resilience, broadening future opportunities through a coaching style both for leaders, staff and children.
 - Be a beacon of best practice for communication.

- Live our Christian values, nurture and love our children, grow their spirituality and continue to welcome our clergy and the church community into the life of the school.
- 9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 29 April 2020.
