Dear Parents and Carers,

Today has been a royal day in school as we celebrated the Coronation of King Charles III. We started off the day with a special celebration assembly and we were in awe of the dressing up efforts of all of the pupils! There was a sea of red, white and blue! In class, the children learned about the historical event that is taking place tomorrow in London and all of the children designed a wooden medallion to commemorate the King's Coronation. The children learned about the symbolism of the images on the coronation invitation such as The Green Man:

- He represents spring and rebirth to celebrate the new reign and is formed from leaves of oak, ivy and hawthorn which are symbolic flowers of the United Kingdom
- The flowers appear in groupings of 3 signifying The King becoming the third monarch of his name



Friends of Leatherhead Trinity have also purchased each child a commemorative pencil. Nursery children who attend the beginning of the week sessions will receive their pencils on Tuesday.

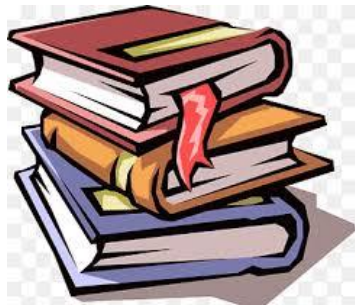
