Dear Parents and Carers,

On Tuesday we launched our consultation on increasing our school day in line with the Government's expectation of a school week being 32.5hrs. The proposed changes are:

Reception, KS1 and KS2 8.50am – 3.20pm.

This means that the school day will start 5 minutes earlier, and it will end at 3.20pm for all pupils in Reception, KS1 and KS2. Any changes will take effect from September 2023. There are to be no changes currently to the school day/sessions for Nursery.

A brilliant win for Eagle class this week with an amazing 99% attendance! It's so good to see more classes hitting the 97%.


