Are you entitled?



You can help us help your child by completing an eligibility application form.

This allows us to check if your child is entitled to Free School Meals and also if the Pupil Premium Grant can be claimed from the Government. As a school we then use this additional funding to enable your child to be supported to reach their full potential. You may apply whenever you think you may be eligible. Even if you think you would only be eligible for a short time or if your child is getting free meals as a YR, Y1 or Y2 child, please apply as it makes a big difference to your child and to the school.

Can my child trigger this extra funding for school?

Yes, if you are receiving one of the following:

- Income support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Universal Credit

- Are either or both parents members of HM Armed Forces or in receipt of a child pension from the Ministry of Defence?
- Has your child been adopted or is your child under a special guardianship, child arrangement or a residence order?
- Has your child been looked after by Social Care for at least 1 day?

If you believe your child is entitled to receive the Pupil Premium Grant then please ask for an Eligibility Application Form. We will then check and notify you if the application has been successful.
